



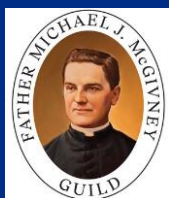

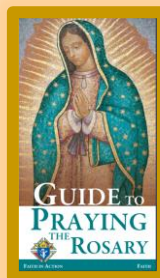

Pay Attention, it's gonna be on the test!

Remember that teacher in high school or that professor in college who kept going over the same thing, over and over again, to the point you just quit listening? Then one day you walk in and they hand out a test; that's when you realize you should have been listening, that's when you realize they were telling you all along what's on the test – duh

There are two things to learn from that:

First, if they keep going over something, that's code for; it's going to be on the test!

Second, listen to what they're saying so you have the right answer!

It's like that in the Bible too.

For some time now, Pam's been reading and praying the Psalms. Not long ago, we were talking and she wanted me to listen to Psalm 19. When she was finished, I said, "now let's read Psalm 51".

Psalm 19:13 reads: "Who can detect trespasses? Cleanse me from my inadvertent sins.

Psalm 51:9 reads "Cleanse me with hyssop, that I may be pure: wash me and I will be whiter than snow".

And Psalm 51 goes on, vs 12 reads: "A clean heart create for me, God; renew within me a steadfast spirit".

This theme, this concept of asking God to cleanse us, keeps coming up again and again. It runs all through the Bible, in Isaiah, in Ezekiel, in Daniel, in the Psalms, in Paul's letters. Over and over again.

This is God in the Bible telling us to get our priorities straight, to acknowledge our weaknesses and sins and ask God to wash us clean, and to put in us a steadfast spirit, a spirit of love and forgiveness towards others, and ourselves.

This theme is even in The Lord's Prayer: "forgive us our trespass's as we forgive those who trespass against us".

So many times, we joust with the wrong windmills; we consume ourselves with fixing the things that will fix themselves if we leave them alone, and in doing so, ignoring the things that need our attention. This is God teaching us how to know the difference.

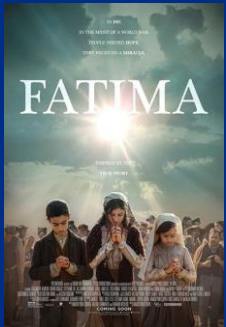
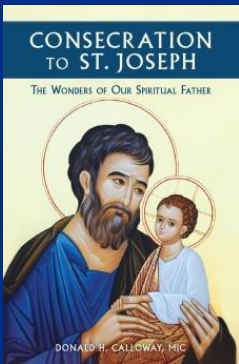
When we ask God to cleanse us, we are asking Him to cleanse us of our sins, our anger, our prejudices. When we ask him to put in us a steadfast spirit, we are asking Him to teach us that we are not the center of the universe, we are not our own little gods. We are asking Him to teach us His ways, His truths, His pure love, and not to be swayed by the ways of the world around us.

We are asking Him to teach us how to live in His pure love and peace; the Shalom of God.

This is God telling us over and over again to pay attention; because brothers, this is His code for;

"it's going to be on the test!!!"

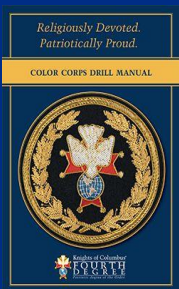

SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

“Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven.” (Gospel for Jan. 29, Mt 5:11-12a)

It often isn't popular to be a true follower of Jesus. That can especially be the case when we express our faith in public ways. For example, many Christians who have prayed outside an abortion facility have experienced hostility for their beliefs. But when we stand up courageously for truth and righteousness — even when we face opposition or persecution to do so — we know we do so as followers of Christ.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to give witness to your faith and love by supporting the pro-life cause in some concrete way, such as by donating your time or other resources. Second, I challenge you to participate in the ASAP, Novena for Life, and/or March for Life [programs](#).

Questions for Reflection:

Are you willing to suffer as a disciple of Christ, as Jesus warned would happen? Do you sometimes fail to speak up for your faith or moral values out of a desire to be liked by others or to not “rock the boat”? What concrete, practical things can you do to strengthen your willingness and ability to publicly witness to your faith, even when it might be unpopular — or come with a cost?

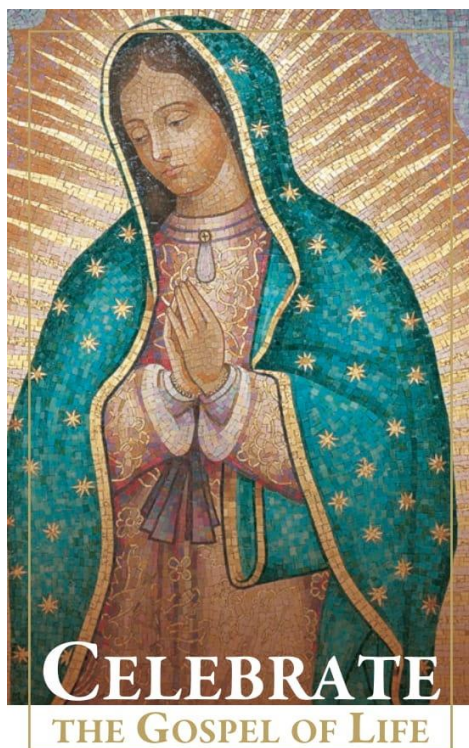

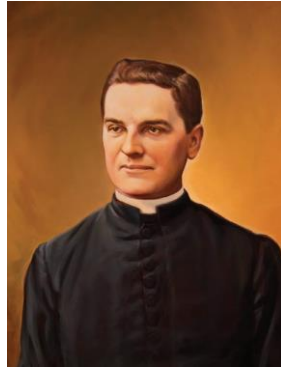

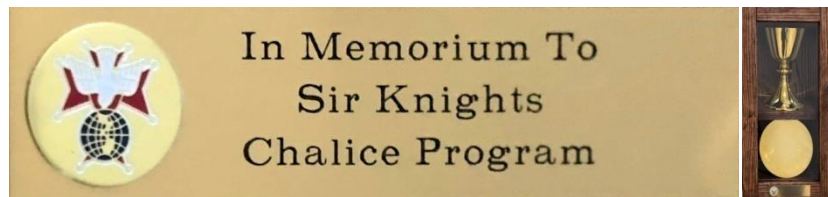
