Consecration to Our Lady of Guadalupe Renewed

Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly renewed the consecration of the Order to Mary under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe during a recent Board of Directors pilgrimage to Mexico City. The renewal took place Feb. 3 at the conclusion of Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe celebrated by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori of Baltimore. Msgr. Eduardo Chávez, postulator for St. Juan Diego's cause for canonization and a canon of the basilica, was among the concelebrants.

The initial consecration, which took place at the basilica 22 years ago, on Feb. 3, 2001, was undertaken by Past Supreme Knight Carl Anderson upon his formal installation as the 13th supreme knight. It was inspired in part by Pope John Paul II's 1999 apostolic exhortation *Ecclesia in America* (The Church in America), in which the pope called for greater unity across the continent and acclaimed Our Lady of Guadalupe as "Patroness of all America and Star of the first and new evangelization."

In brief remarks to the Board of Directors and guests, Supreme Knight Kelly affirmed, "Our devotion to Our Lady of Guadalupe has continued to grow stronger, in councils and in parishes throughout the Order and in every country where we are present."

Echoing Mary's words to St. Juan Diego in 1531, the supreme knight added: "Our Lady inspires us and guides us in all of our efforts — especially those for the sake of the unborn and the most vulnerable — and we take constant solace in knowing that she is here, she who is our mother."

Following his remarks, Supreme Knight Kelly led the congregants in reciting the Litany of the Blessed Virgin. Archbishop Lori then recited the Prayer of the Reconsecration. The solemn reconsecration concluded with remarks by Msgr. Eduardo Chávez.

The Knights of Columbus has been present in Mexico since 1905, when Supreme Knight Edward Hearn visited Mexico City to install officers of Guadalupe Council 1050.



Geroge Orwell once said:

"In a time of universal deceit, telling the truth is a revolutionary act"

Pontious Pilot asks Jesus "what is truth?", for many reasons a uniquely interesting question to ask, but one reason is, at that time Jesus was considered by many to be a revolutionary.

At the Last Supper Jesus answers Thomas, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me". John 14:6

This isn't going to be an easy fight; they've been at it for a very long time while we weren't watching: shame on us.


Winston Churchill said:

And it is in dying that we are born to Eternal Life. Amen



Supreme Master Michael McCusker

Michael McCusker of Memphis, Tennessee, was elected to lead the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus as supreme master; he will also continue as a member of the Board of Directors, following his election to that position last August. McCusker, a decorated military veteran, succeeds Dennis Stoddard, who retires March 1 after 13 years as supreme master. In recognition of Stoddard's distinguished record of accomplishments, the Board of Directors voted to accord him the honorary title of supreme master emeritus.



A member of the Knights of Columbus since 1988, Michael McCusker served as state deputy of Tennessee from 2019 to 2021 and was elected to the Board of Directors in August 2022.

McCusker has worked as a criminal prosecutor for more than 20 years and currently is assistant district attorney general for the 30th Judicial District of Tennessee. He also served in the U.S. Army Reserves, and then the Tennessee National Guard, for more than two decades, including a deployment to Afghanistan from 2005 to 2006. McCusker was awarded a Bronze Star for his service in Afghanistan, as well as an Army Commendation Medal for his actions during a search-and-rescue mission there in 2005.

McCusker is a graduate of the University of Tennessee and earned his law degree from the University of Memphis. He is a member of St. Michael the Archangel Council 17578 in Memphis. He and his wife, Theresa, live in Germantown, Tennessee, and have three children.

The beautiful tradition of St. Joseph's Table comes from Italy where St. Joseph is highly venerated. The Feast of St. Joseph is celebrated annually in March. Tradition has it that a large feast of special Italian foods is prepared and served from an altar/shrine erected in honor of St. Joseph. In times of need, hardship or struggle, Italian families turn to the loving compassion of St. Joseph and pray for his intercession. Tradition also calls for asking St. Joseph to intercede on behalf of the needs of a community. There is no charge for the meal, instead, attendees are asked to consider making a free-will offering to support those community intentions. 



Shrines of Switzerland and a Rhine River Cruise


May 23, 2023 - June 2, 2023



MARCH 2023 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." (Gospel for March 5, Mt 17:7)

"Do not be afraid" — we read these words often in Scripture. Here, Jesus speaks to the apostles, awestruck at his Transfiguration. In a similar way, the angel told St. Joseph, "Do not be afraid" to take Mary, who had conceived the Christ Child, as his wife. The knowledge that God is with us should encourage and strengthen us. Sometimes, as with the apostles, we are overwhelmed by the mysteries of faith; at other times the challenges of living our faith in a secular culture seem daunting. Yet Christ continually empowers us as he calls us: "Rise, and do not be afraid."

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, in which we celebrate the feast of St. Joseph, I challenge you to watch the documentary St. Joseph: Our Spiritual Father (available for free at kofc.org/stjoseph), reflecting on St. Joseph's courage. Second, I challenge you to participate in the Faith in Action Pilgrim Icon program, which features an icon of St. Joseph.

Questions for Reflection:

What are you afraid of? Do your fears prevent you from fully following God's will in your life? How can you imitate the courage of St. Joseph?


