MAY 2023 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

"I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you." (Gospel for May 14, Jn 14:18)

Jesus keeps his promises to us. He does not leave us orphans. He appeared to the disciples several times after he rose from the dead. He gave us the Eucharist, his real presence, to nourish us until the end of time. He said he would return at his Second Coming. And there's another way he did not leave us orphans: He gave us his own mother to be ours. Let us turn to the Blessed Mother often with our needs and prayers of intercession.



There is a theme, (one of many), that runs all thru the Bible, that extends into the world, old and new, and that is experienced today in the Church. It is the idea of taking a pause, then opening back up, to extend Gods love into the world.

In Genisis we hear; "The Lord God then took man and settled him in the garden of Eden, to cultivate and care for it." The casual reading of this phrase is that the man, Adam, would seem to simply be a gardener, a caretaker. However, the theology of this phrase is that God, telling Adam to "cultivate" the garden, is telling Adam to grow it, to expand Eden into the whole world.

And then we read: "The Lord God gave man this order; You are free to eat from any of the trees of the garden except the tree of knowledge of good and evil. From that tree you shall not eat; when you eat from it you shall die." Again, the casual reading of this would be an admonition of what man cannot do. The theology of this is that God gave man the freedom to do whatever he wanted to grow Eden into the whole world, *except that one thing*. Of course, we know how that turned out. When they ate the fruit of that one tree, their special relationship with God died, and heaven was closed.


Everything from that point on, until the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus, was about trying to get that back.

In the books of the Torah, God is setting out the procedures and rituals trying to reconcile us with Him. He sets out the sacrifices, at times in great detail, that we see now as templates for the ultimate sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross. With that sacrifice Jesus accomplishes what all the sacrifices before him fell short of: to reconcile us with God, and heaven was open again. We participate in that sacrifice every time we attend Mass.

But along the way God occasionally took a pause. Not so He could re-think His approach to us, but to give us time to re-think our need for Him.

One of many examples: God told Noah to collect all the animals of the world, two by two, into one place, the Ark. Then God flooded the world. In a manner of speaking, God paused. When the flood was over, God told Noah to open the gates of the Ark and let all the animals back out into the world. That message is clear.

20 times in the history of the Church, she has taken a pause to deal with some immediate issue and/or to consider some deep theological question.




As with Vatican II, some of those questions were about letting the world in to change the Church, and so those questions dealt with the heretical pressures of those who wanted the Church to do just exactly that. Other questions were on issues of a deep theological nature. When all those questions were settled, Vatican II, like all the councils before it, opened the Church to evangelize those answers back out into the world.

Of course, the most recent pause was forced upon us by Covid. But for some of us, this pause gave us time to reconsider our relationship with God and the Church. It gave us time to look deeper into ourselves, and to appreciate how much we missed the Mass. If you're looking for something good that came out of Covid, that should be high on your list.

But, like all virus's before it, Covid has mutated into just another virus. Still deadly to those at risk, but in the same manner they are at risk to all the other virus's as well.

And so, it's time for us to open back out, and take the Church into the world once more.

My brothers, the pause is over.






Shrines of Switzerland and a Rhine River Cruise


STAR COUNCIL

<u>Social Media Communications (part-time)</u> includes managing and promoting social media accounts in cooperation with our marketing strategy goals.

<u>Pro-Life Outreach Coordinator(s)</u> will assist the President and Development Director with organizing, promoting, and recruiting participants for pro-life events like 40 Days for Life and the Jericho Walk.

<u>Receptionist(s)- Part time</u> will welcome clients as they come to the pregnancy medical clinic, make sure forms and completed, entered, and filed, schedule appointments, and do basic office work. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

Spanish-Speaking Client Advocates (Part-time) will assist clients who are Spanish-speaking in our services, from pregnancy testing, options consultation, to case management. At this time, we are not seeing a high-volume of Spanish-speaking clients and so this will be an on-call position for a designated day and time-frame. We are looking for 10 volunteers to commit to 9-12:30 or 12:30-4 on any given day, Monday through Friday. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

<u>Weekend Cleaners</u> will do basic upkeep of building such clean bathrooms, sweep and mop floors, and vacuum.

<u>Office Assistance (part-time)</u> will fulfill basic office duties, filing, organizing, product ordering, printing, and mailing.

Event Planning will assist President and Community Outreach director in various tasks for our annual Gala, Galentine's, and other related events.


