SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" (Gospel for May 4, Jn 21:17a)

When, following the Resurrection, Jesus revealed himself to his disciples at the Sea of Tiberias, why did he ask Peter three times whether he loved him? It has often been seen as a penance for Peter's earlier threefold denial of Christ. But perhaps there's something more — perhaps Jesus was pushing Peter to reflect more deeply on what it means to love him. Sometimes, we speak the words "I love you" by rote, without grasping their true meaning. May we always be mindful of what it means to truly love someone and to love as Christ taught us.

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to identify one way you can demonstrate true love of God and neighbor. Then pray about how to concretely undertake that sacrificial act of love — and put it into action.

Questions for Reflection:

What does it mean for you to truly love Jesus? Do you know anyone — or is there a particular saint — who has shown you what true love looks like? What are some specific ways you can grow in your ability to truly love?





My argument for the Family:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in paragraph 2207 writes:


"The family is the *original cell of social life*. It is the natural society in which husband and wife give themselves in love and in the gift of life. Authority, stability, and life or relationships within the family constitute the foundations for freedom, security, and fraternity within society. The family is the community in which, from childhood, one can learn moral values, begin to honor God, and make good use of freedom. Family life is an initiation into life in society."

In recent years in this country, we as Catholics and others of good moral standing, have seen the very disturbing developments in our society that, "seeks to educate our children about free love, about the nature of sexual intercourse, about the archaic nature of family codes, about the outdatedness of monogamy, and the irrelevance of the authority of the church, and to ignore the precepts of morality." This quote comes from the biographer who was describing Gorge Lukacs, who we will discuss in a moment. Parents who go to school board meetings to protest this education, who want a say in their children's education, are labeled as "domestic terrorists."

This same tact is used against pro-life activists at abortion clinics in the US and around the world because we understand the sanctity of life, and we also clearly understand that abortion is one of the fundamental core issues necessary to destroy the family. There is so much more to talk about, but so little time and space here, because we know that this is just the tip of the iceberg.

To get a better picture of what is happening today, Mike Gonzales, writing for the Heritage Foundation, connects some interesting dots for us. We must look back to 1848 and Karl Marx, who in his manifesto, calls for the complete abolishment of the family, and just as important, that the education of children must be conducted by the state, *not the parents*. Immediately after the Soviet came into power in Russia in 1917, this Marxist policy was put in place. The first Peoples Commissar for Welfare, Alexandra Kollontai wrote: "The old family, narrow and petty, where the parents quarrel and are only interested in their own offspring, is not capable of educating the 'new person'."

In 1919, Hungarian communists managed to establish a Hungarian soviet and this education concept was carried over. George Lukacs was the Hungarian commissar for education, and as noted, the above quote describes his education of children.

Fortunately, the typical Hungarian would have none of it, and the Hungarian soviet only lasted 133 days. George Lukacs escaped with is life and later influenced a group of neo-communist academics in Germany that we know as "the Frankfurt School." Gonzales has just connected Marx through Kollontai and Lukacs to the Frankfurt School in Germany that strongly advocated for the theories of Marx, Kollontai, and especially the depraved teachings of Lukacs.

In his book, "The Devil and Karl Marx" Paul Kengor clearly identifies the theory and teaching of "the Frankfurt School" as fundamental in the actions of the American Communist Party in the early 1930's as they began to infiltrate American education systems and Church's in their effort to destroy religion and more basically, the family. And yet, the family survives, and more importantly, it flourishes. G.K. Chesterton argues the family, in our written history, was born of a sense of religion, and was certainly born in the very basic fabric of society, even before pre-historic times.

The father and mother, male and female, are required in our basic biology to create the child that completes a triangle that is repeated everywhere throughout the world and throughout history, a triad that is most importantly, especially at this time in our liturgical year, seen in the Holy Family.

The Catholic Church has always recognized this as one of the foundational stones of the Church, the Jews have always recognized this as the foundation of their Covenant with God, as have so many other religions and faiths around the world who have always understood their connection with God starts in the family, in that triangle.

The Catholic Church rests the responsibility for the education of the children on the shoulders of the father and mother: "As those first responsible for the education of their children, parents have the right to *choose a school for them*, (emphasis is CCC), which corresponds to their own convictions. *This right is fundamental*, (emphasis mine)." CCC 2228

Simply put, the family, as an institution of God, will always survive. In his book "The Story of the Family" Chesterton writes: "This triangle of truisms, of father, mother and child, cannot be destroyed; it can only destroy those civilizations that disregard it."

Let that sink in for a while



Regalia Wear – the KofC Fourth Degree standard is "One Button" used on the jacket. See the Drill Manual for photographic examples. The Bottom Button of the jacket is not used.

The Drill Manual contains significant changes including certification of Color Corps Members in Marching and Manual of the Sword (Appendix A), as well as appearance standards (Appendix C).

Could the wear the Fourth Degree uniform blazer with other slacks and a regular tie when going out with this wife? The answer is: No

Our uniform was designed to be worn complete with the Fourth Degree blazer, official slacks, tie, and official Fourth Degree pin (PG-113). It also requires a white dress shirt with no button-down collar, black shoes, and black socks. However, it may be worn in social settings such as Knights of Columbus events, banquets, exemplifications, meetings, and church.

The other components of the uniform are used when participating in our color corps (color guard or honor guard). Those include the official beret with flash representing office (if any), white gloves, a service baldric, a Fourth Degree sword with scabbard. Flag bearers would not wear baldric or sword. (Note that the service baldric is either a general member baldric or else a specific color to indicate your current office held).

So, if you want to show your pride as a member of the Fourth Degree, then wear all the components according to the laws and rules of the Fourth Degree.






