#### SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always." (Gospel for June 8, Jn 14:15-16)

Last month, we reflected on how Jesus probed Peter three times with the question "Do you love me?" 

Why Peters Denials Are Not the Last Word

I'm going to do something this month that I don't ever remember doing in the years I've been writing this reflection for the Council. I'm going to use someone else's reflection, and I'll tell you why.

Fr. Carney and I were e-mailing back and forth on a question I had Tuesday morning of Holy Week. Later that day, I ran into him at the new Sprouts and we picked up that conversation. Part of that conversation turned to forgiveness of sin and he asked me if I had read the reflection in the Magnificat for that morning. Now, understand I'm talking to a priest, so of course I couldn't lie, I told him I hadn't. He told me I should, he thought it was one of the best he had read in some time.

So, here it is:


"There are many who, after a conversion from serious sin, cannot read of St. Peter's confident promise to Jesus at the Last Supper – *I will lay down my life for you* – without wondering if, like Peter, three imminent denials await them in the near future ... but as the Gospel testifies, the three denials of St. Peter did not end there. They were succeeded by an implacable divine pursuit and by three questions of love directed to Peter by the resurrected Christ in the early morning light at the shore of the Sea of Galilee......

Every converted soul should take note of St. John of the Cross's insight that memory is purified by the virtue of hope. Certainly, past events do not change, including our sins. There is a fixed, factual truth to everything that has happened, in irrecoverable character to earlier choices, and effects that may be still consequential...in this sense, the past cannot be taken back. We may regret sin and repent, but events do not evaporate and disappear, and sometimes the memory of them causes disturbance. Yet the virtue of hope, rather than dimming memory, can cause a different kind of remembrance.

Looking back at sin, we can perceive what we had not realized in the past: God in an utterly personal manner was present in the perseverance of love through that lost time, keeping pace with us even as we may have plunged recklessly into sin. He was preparing our rescue even while we were oblivious to his love. Perhaps there were many quiet approaches to our soul even unknown to us. He never renounced us, and he never cast us from his gaze ... In the perspective of divine providence and of God's love for souls, all is open to possibility, nothing is closed or determined, and God is swift to repeat after every misfortune that he is not deterred by human mistakes.

Hope not only makes all things possible, but grants a vivid sense of the realistic likelihood that God will indeed accomplish all things he desires. And what he desires above all to complete is the surrender of our life to himself."

This was written by Fr. Donald Haggerty, a priest of the Archdiocese Of New York, serving at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City, and was in the Tuesday of Holy Week Magnificat.

Peter denied Jesus three times, but professed his love for Him three times again when asked by Jesus. Peter spent the rest of his live living for Jesus, and then dying for Him.

And so my brothers, we say we will die for Jesus, and for our faith, but will we LIVE for Jesus, and our faith that God will always forgive our sins every time we ask? Is our faith strong enough to trust that all we have to do is ask with a pure heart?



# In Step

#### **Message From Fourth Degree Director of Training**

This past week I had the honor to serve at the wake and funeral for a fallen brother and friend. Our Grand Knight took a video of a few of our postings and texted them to me. Although I think we did a fine job, there were a few things we really need to work on, and the first thing was keeping in step with your partner.

Our entrance was fine; the departure from the posting with our members who just did a shift is where we got lazy. When working in pairs, make sure you keep the same pace as your partner, start off the same (left foot), keep in line with your partner, stop at the same time, use your peripheral vision to slow down or speed up, work with your partner after each shift to work out anything you know can be improved.

This should be practiced as much as the proper carry and present sword at a call out. We want to be sure that we honor our brothers and their wives by being as professional as possible at a call out.

At your next Assembly meeting, please take 15 minutes to practice keeping in step with your partner, starting off on your left foot, nice pace at entrance and departure (this is not a race to the back of the room). Honing your skills as a member of the Color Corps is essential and appreciated.

#### **Updated Drill Manual**

The Drill Manual contains significant changes including certification of Color Corps Members in Marching and Manual of the Sword (Appendix A), as well as appearance standards (Appendix C).

Regalia Wear – the KofC Fourth Degree standard is "One Button" used on the jacket. See the Drill Manual for photographic examples. The Bottom Button of the jacket is not used.

Could the wear the Fourth Degree uniform blazer with other slacks and a regular tie when going out with this wife? The answer is: No

Our uniform was designed to be worn complete with the Fourth Degree blazer, official slacks, tie, and official Fourth Degree pin (PG-113). It also requires a white dress shirt with no button-down collar, black shoes, and black socks. However, it may be worn in social settings such as Knights of Columbus events, banquets, exemplifications, meetings, and church.

The other components of the uniform are used when participating in our color corps (color guard or honor guard). Those include the official beret with flash representing office (if any), white gloves, a service baldric, a Fourth Degree sword with scabbard. Flag bearers would not wear baldric or sword. (Note that the service baldric is either a general member baldric or else a specific color to indicate your current office held).

So, if you want to show your pride as a member of the Fourth Degree, then wear all the components according to the laws and rules of the Fourth Degree.






