


#### Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:



## From Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

July 2023

Don't give up, we *can* take this back.

I was reading an article in Epoch Times the other day about a mother's battle to get her daughter back from the transgender path she was going down. The article was both enlightening and disturbing. Enlightening in her education about this culture, and disturbing at the realization of how deep, and dark, this culture really is, and how long this has been going on.

She talked about how the meaning of some of the words used in this culture had changed, and that there were new words that she had never heard before, which made it harder for her to understand the complete depth of what was happening to her daughter. A lot of this was coming from her daughter's school, whether the teachers were outright teaching this, or if the school simply made the conscious decision to not address it. In the end, either decision made very little difference in the level of destruction of the child, and the family.

It has been said, he who controls the message controls the society. Today, as in generations past, we know this to be true. Hitler knew it, Stalin knew it, Mao knew it, and those who are pushing this woke agenda also know it, and they are educating our younger generations with this agenda, in our schools, social media, broadcast media, entertainment, and in our news.

To this mother's comment that the meaning of some terms had changed, in her book, "Awake, Not Woke", Noelle Mering makes the point that our ability to communicate with each other in an effective way relies on the common understanding of the words we use. For an agenda to change the meaning of those words, or to invent new words without common understanding, or are understood only within a very narrow agenda, is to destroy our ability to communicate, and begins the process of destroying a society.

A good example is the alphabet mafia, (a term my 18-year-old grandson used the other day). The meaning of the words associated with the letters, with more added daily, changes depending on who's running the woke agenda on any given day. The message is very confusing, but that's by design. It would be easy, as some do, to feel that this is getting worse, to the point that all is lost, and we can't win, that we have no other choice but to succumb to the dehumanization imposed on us. This is the message the woke agenda wants us to hear.

But the immediate and stunning reaction to Bud Light was nothing short of amazing, and it sent a very different message. It sent a message that we can take this back. This mother was ultimately successful in getting her daughter back, and that sent a very different message also.

It's a message that our prayers are working, so we must keep praying, that our actions to take a non-violent stand are working. Take a stand by signing the six referendums to stop the six bills this governor signed into law, and continue to stand against all other woke attempts to destroy our society.

Keep working to stop abortion. While burrito sales don't sound like much in the overall scheme of things, it makes a difference. If one burrito sale saved one life, then we made a difference.

Keep doing the little things, for someday we'll look back and realize they were the things that made big differences.

These are messages of hope, that if we stand with God, God will stand with us. A message Israel had to learn repeatedly in the Old Testament, but is still true today.

A message of: do not give up, we can take this back.

It strikes me however, that how the woke agenda is responding to this can only be described as desperation.

So be warned: desperate people can very often be dangerous people.

Lord, make me an instrument of Your Peace: Where there is hatred, let me sow love; Where there is injury, pardon; Where there is doubt, faith; Where there is despair, hope; Where there is darkness, light; And where there is sadness, joy.

O Divine Master, Grant that I may not so much seek To be consoled as to console; To be understood, as to understand; To be loved, as to love;

And it is in dying that we are born to Eternal Life. Amen








### **STAR COUNCIL**

## WANT TO VOLUNTEER?

<u>Social Media Communications (part-time)</u> includes managing and promoting social media accounts in cooperation with our marketing strategy goals.

**Pro-Life Outreach Coordinator(s)** will assist the President and Development Director with organizing, promoting, and recruiting participants for pro-life events like 40 Days for Life and the Jericho Walk.

<u>**Receptionist(s)-Part time</u>** will welcome clients as they come to the pregnancy medical clinic, make sure forms and completed, entered, and filed, schedule appointments, and do basic office work. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.</u>

**Spanish-Speaking Client Advocates (Part-time)** will assist clients who are Spanish-speaking in our services, from pregnancy testing, options consultation, to case management. At this time, we are not seeing a high-volume of Spanish-speaking clients and so this will be an on-call position for a designated day and time-frame. We are looking for 10 volunteers to commit to 9-12:30 or 12:30-4 on any given day, Monday through Friday. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

<u>Weekend Cleaners</u> will do basic upkeep of building such clean bathrooms, sweep and mop floors, and vacuum.

<u>Office Assistance (part-time)</u> will fulfill basic office duties, filing, organizing, product ordering, printing, and mailing.

**Event Planning** will assist President and Community Outreach director in various tasks for our annual Gala, Galentine's, and other related events.


