





### From Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

August 2023

Pam and I were at the KOA outside of Santa Fe a while back and for the first time in a very long while I was able to look up at the sky and see stars without the light pollution of a near-by city. It took me back 60 years to that 11-year-old boy who looked up at the stars and wondered what's up there, and what's beyond all that. That 11 year old boy who asked even then, "are we alone in the universe"?

If we believe in God, if we believe God created the universe, then we're asking the wrong question. Are we alone in the universe? NO, God has always been with us, we have never been alone. Hebrews 11:3 tells us this: "By faith we understand that the universe was ordered by the Word of God, so that the visible came into being through the invisible."

So, the question we should be asking is, "are there others out there?"

This is the age-old question that has been asked for thousands of years. Some scientist and astronomers tell us the numbers point to other civilizations out there. Other scientists use that same data to prove that there are no others out there. Sounds a little like today's politics, doesn't it?

I was talking with David Kihm about something close to this some time back and he was talking about a movie on Amazon Prime called "The Privileged Planet." It starts with the premise put forth by Carl Sagen in his Cosmos series, that we are not unique, there is nothing special about us, that we are just a spec of light floating in a vast universe that is far bigger than us mere mortals, that this all came together thru random chance, (something secular science starts any conversation with), and therefore there is no influence from any kind of a concept of intelligent design, or a god.

But, as the movie progresses, it starts to talk about all the factors that must be just right for us to be here. Example; our ability to make decisions and learn beyond our basic needs of food and shelter; our moon that is in just the right place in orbit around us to help provide just the right conditions to sustain life, and not just basic life, but intelligent life that is self-aware. Our planet's location in our galaxy outside of one of the spirals of our galaxy that affords us a much clearer view of the universe, so we can learn more about it; the earth's gravity that is just right, not too little, and not too strong. There are a surprisingly high number of variables, many of which I wouldn't have thought of, that have to be "just right", change any one of these, even by a small percentage, and it all falls apart. All these variables go into a formula that scientist use to help determine if there are others out there. The formula pretty much precludes that chance.

As the movie comes to the end, it starts to make the point that because all these variables have to be just right, that there are so many variables that have to be just right, that the formula begins to rule out random chance, and we begin to understand that we are special, we are unique in the universe; because of our God given ability to learn, to ask questions, and to explore, we begin to understand our purpose and our reason for being here. All of this clearly points to intelligent design, and intelligent design clearly points to God.



As intelligent beings, we ask questions, and we search out answers. And when we get those answer's, we find they ask 5 more questions, and we search out those answers, and on and on. And we try to explain and understand those answers. But here's the rub, science that denies God cannot explain or fully understand those answers without 5 or 6 or 58 different theories, all of them competing, and none of them get it right. On the other hand, science that starts with God doesn't have any of those issues.

Science without God says there was nothing before the Big Bang. The second half of Hebrews 11:3 tells us again that's not true: "so that the visible came into being through the invisible." The authors of Hebrews knew this all those years ago, long before all these scientists today who start their 5 or 6 or 58 different theories without God.


Those of us who have ever done any computer programming or code writing know how important it is to get just the right code to get the desired results, and we know this is no easy task.

Look at it this way; in my mind's eye, I see God writing the perfect program, using the perfect code, and when He's done, He hits "start", <u>and that was the Big Bang</u>. Everything else after that is part of His perfect code, His perfect design, and it includes our ability to learn, to explore, and to better understand, and if we understand it starts with God, it includes our ability to come closer to God.

When you leave here tonight, look up at the sky, let your imagination run, and tell me you've never asked that question.

Are there others out there? As the formula would seem to indicate, not likely. But, when my time comes and I stand before Jesus for my judgement; when he gets to the end and He asks: "now, do you have any questions?"

Well - you know I gotta ask !!!







#### WANT TO VOLUNTEER?

<u>Social Media Communications (part-time)</u> includes managing and promoting social media accounts in cooperation with our marketing strategy goals.

<u>Pro-Life Outreach Coordinator(s)</u> will assist the President and Development Director with organizing, promoting, and recruiting participants for pro-life events like 40 Days for Life and the Jericho Walk.

<u>Receptionist(s)- Part time</u> will welcome clients as they come to the pregnancy medical clinic, make sure forms and completed, entered, and filed, schedule appointments, and do basic office work. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

**Spanish-Speaking Client Advocates (Part-time)** will assist clients who are Spanish-speaking in our services, from pregnancy testing, options consultation, to case management. At this time, we are not seeing a high-volume of Spanish-speaking clients and so this will be an on-call position for a designated day and time-frame. We are looking for 10 volunteers to commit to 9-12:30 or 12:30-4 on any given day, Monday through Friday. Client Advocacy training will be required and provided by PDL.

<u>Weekend Cleaners</u> will do basic upkeep of building such clean bathrooms, sweep and mop floors, and vacuum.

<u>Office Assistance (part-time)</u> will fulfill basic office duties, filing, organizing, product ordering, printing, and mailing.

**Event Planning** will assist President and Community Outreach director in various tasks for our annual Gala, Galentine's, and other related events.


