## SEPTEMBER 2024 SUPREME CHAPLAIN'S MONTHLY CHALLENGE

**And he asked them, “But who do you say that I am?” Peter said to him in reply, “You are the Messiah.” (Gospel for Sept. 15, Mk 8:29)**

Peter was the first of the apostles to openly profess Jesus as the awaited Messiah, the Christ or anointed one. Today, every Christian is called to proclaim in word and deed that Jesus is the Christ. We must never lose the awe and wonder of recognizing Jesus as the Messiah and Savior, especially when we encounter him in the sacrament of penance and in the Mass.

### Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to make Peter’s profession of faith — “You are the Messiah” — a frequent aspiration, or short prayer, you recite throughout each day, perhaps writing it down some place you will see it regularly to remind yourself.

### Questions for Reflection:

When you say the name of Jesus Christ, are you mindful of what this truly means? When you approach a priest for confession, are you fully cognizant that the absolution you receive through the priest comes from Christ himself? When you approach holy Communion, do you recognize and contemplate Jesus’ real presence in the Eucharist you receive?

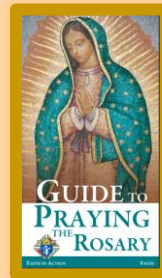

## Worthy Lecturer SK Jimm White

I've used this reflection before, but I think sometimes it's important to remind ourselves of what really matters in our lives. Father John sent this to me a few years ago, and I go back to it from time to time just to help me stay centered.

The author is not known, but when I did some digging I learned this is generally attributed to a confederate soldier during the Civil War.

"I asked God for strength, that I might achieve; I was made weak that I might learn humbly to obey.

I asked for health that I might do great things; I was given sickness that I might do better things.

I asked for riches that I might be happy; I was given poverty that I might be wise.

I asked for power to have the praise of others; I was given weakness to feel the need for God.

I asked for all things that I might enjoy life; I was given life that I may enjoy all things.

I received nothing I asked for - but everything I hoped for.....

Almost despite myself, my unspoken prayer was answered: I am, among all people, most richly blessed".

This soldier's prayer calls us, I think, to look past our ego's, to humble ourselves, to look past the noise all around us and to find the center, the middle, where we better understand what is truly important, where we can more clearly see the face of Jesus in everyone around us.

And I wonder if this doesn't call us to reach out to Christians of other denominations, to other God fearing people, to our Jewish brothers and sisters; to seek out what we have in common, rather than what divides us, and to come together to fight against the evil we see all around us in the world today. We know Satan is the great divider

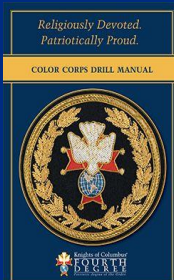
This soldier's prayer calls us to accept our weakness's, to embrace them as our strength's. Paul tells us, "when I am weak, that is when I am strongest".

Jesus sought out the weak, the poor, the least of us and exalted them.

And so my brothers, that's the message here, the message for all of us.
