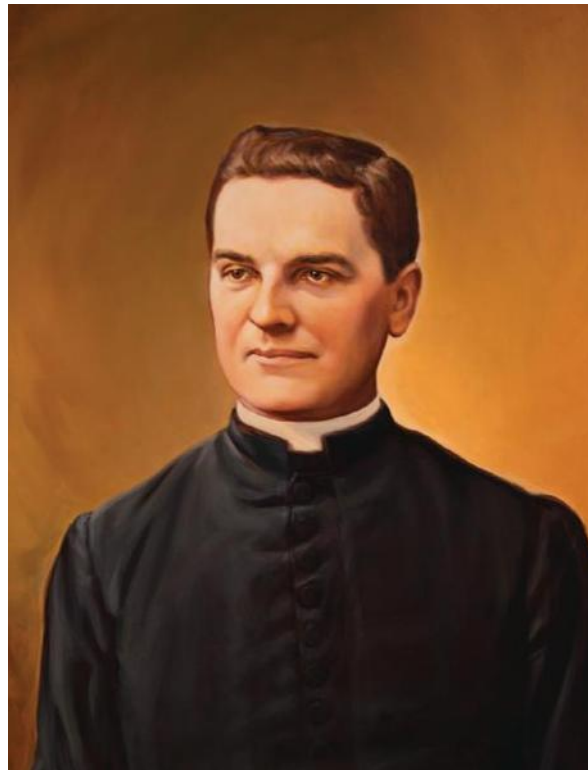

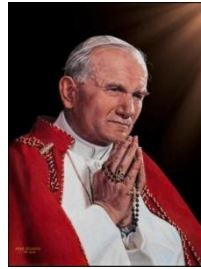

Supreme Chaplain's Monthly Challenge

August 2026

He turned and said to Peter, “Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle to me. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do.” (Gospel for Aug. 30, Mt 16:23)

Who knows the mind of God? God is beyond human understanding, yet he has revealed himself to us most perfectly in the person of Jesus Christ. Through prayer we can come to know God more fully, and we grow in understanding of his plan when we make a habit of conforming our will to his holy will. We follow Christ in discipleship when we pray daily to the Father as he did: “Not my will but yours be done” (Lk 22:42).

Challenge by Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William E. Lori:

This month, I challenge you to study the life and example of our founder, Blessed Michael McGivney, whose feast day is Aug. 13. Use the *Blessed Michael McGivney Cor Session Guide* (freely available at kofc.org/shopcis), noting in particular how Father McGivney always sought to align his will with that of God.

Questions for Reflection:

How can you strive to better understand things from God’s perspective? How can you discern when your thoughts are merely human thoughts and not of God? What virtues of Blessed Michael McGivney can you imitate in order to submit yourself more fully to God’s holy will?

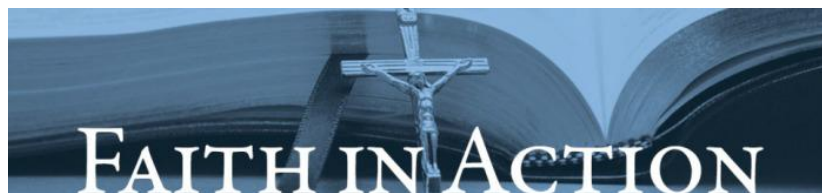

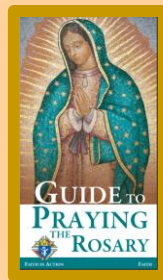

My argument for where forgiveness lives.

There is right and there is wrong, and somewhere in the middle there is compassion, there is empathy, and there is forgiveness.

The Church's stand on the moral teachings of homosexuality and transgender are, by every measure, very conservative. But the conservative values of Mother Church also commands us to love and respect the dignity and humanity of everyone around us, without judgment; and that is often missed in the conversations, sometimes I fear, intentionally.

Paragraph 2357 of The Catechism of the Catholic Church clearly identifies homosexual *life style* as a deprivation of God's natural law, to procreate, thus, a sin.

But in paragraph 2358, the Catechism instructs us to treat people with those tendencies with dignity, respect, and sensitivity. It goes on to instruct us to live our lives in such a way as to be a positive example to them and in doing so help them to find a way out of that sin. As St. Francis de Assisi says, "Preach the Gospel at all times... if necessary, use words".

It is important, especially today, to be very clear that in following the instruction of the Catechism, we do not confuse showing dignity, respect, and love with somehow condoning or celebrating that sin.

But this is important too, the overall sense of 2358 and 2359 also tells us not to judge.

For me, knowing that they will stand before Jesus for their judgement, and knowing it is not for me to do, I can now appreciate all the other great strengths many of them bring to the table. I have heard it said, "judge the sin, not the sinner".

I worked with one such man in the hospital during covid. He was, and had been a good friend for many years, but was clearly gay. He was also the director of the covid unit for the entire two years. I am certain, as many others were, that he was clearly responsible for making that one of the best covid units in the entire Southwest, and in doing so, was responsible for saving lives. That's the value he brought to the table in that hospital. Had he been judged unworthy, the hospital, and its covid patients, would have suffered a great loss.

When we finally closed that unit, some of the doctors, nurses, and aids who had been in that unit for those two years left medicine entirely. Only through compassion and empathy can one understand what those years felt like to those in that unit, and to all the rest of us in the hospital as well.

Those two years also brought the rest of us closer as a family, and in doing so, many found ways to forgive petty differences with each other, and in a strange way, created another sense of healing. Funny place for forgiveness to live or maybe not.

There is right and there is wrong, and somewhere in the middle there is compassion, there is empathy, and there is forgiveness.

Amen

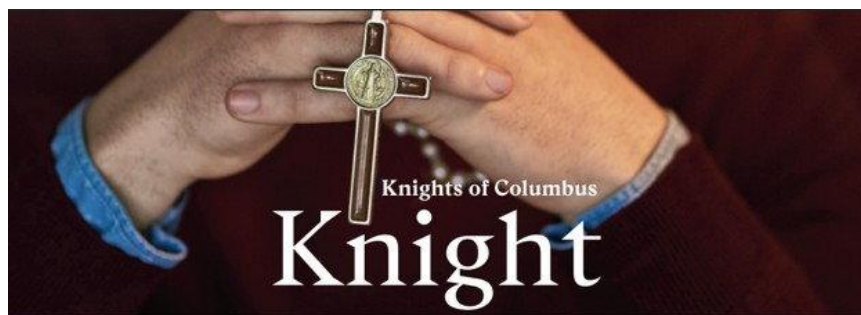

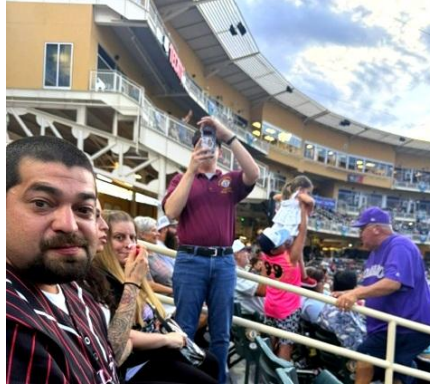

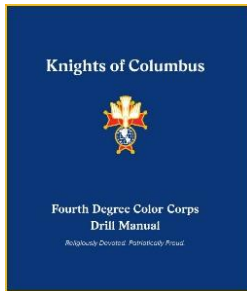

Proper Present Sword

At a recent honor guard at my Parish, we had 14 Sir Knights that came early in the week for an Honor Guard.

How thankful we were for so many to show during the week. Our brothers that attended were mostly retired, and mainly over the age of 70.

We practiced our entrance, recession, and escorting the gifts for 30 minutes prior to the mass.

After mass the deacon serving was a Fourth-Degree brother Knight and member of our assembly. I asked, "how did we look?"

His response was one I was waiting for, "You guys looked great, but your swords were everywhere"

When dealing with an honor guard of men who varied in age from the late 50's to the early 80's, how does the honor guard stay consistent?

Practice is certainly a top choice but also keeping in mind the strength of your members and knowing if any member may have lost the ability to hold a sword at attention for a long period of time. This would require the CCC, Marshal, or whoever is leading the honor guard to be sensitive to when you go to present, where you place your weaker members in line, and how long you wait before you line up. Let's be sensitive to our aging members who have given a lot of time, effort, and energy to the Fourth Degree, we want them to participate as long as they can, but to also make sure that we are presenting ourselves in the best possible way. Any other suggestions you have would be appreciated and shared.

Just to refresh all of us, here is the proper present sword for all honor guards.

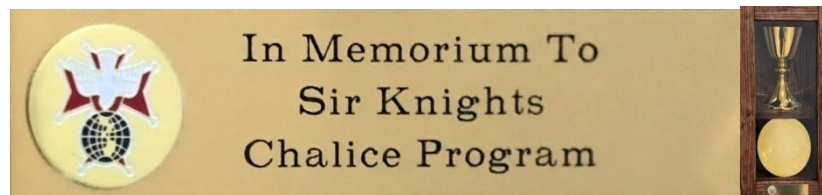

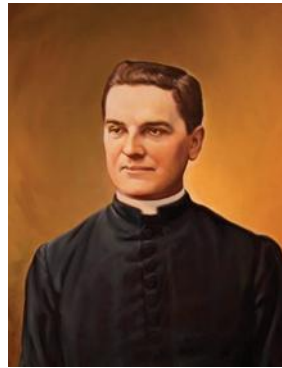
